24 HOUR URINE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Obtain a urine container from your physician or the laboratory staff. The container should be clean, dry and will not contain any preservatives, liquids or powders.
- 2. Check to make sure your full name is on the collection jug. It is important that your specimen is labeled with your name (first and last).
- 3. **Discard the first urine on the morning you begin the collection**. From this point on, you place all urine in your collection jug. Please <u>note the start time and date on the jug</u>.
- 4. Save all urine during the day and the night, placing it in the plastic jug. Keep the jug refrigerated during the entire collection, for example on ice in a cooler, or in the refrigerator.
- 5. **The following morning, SAVE your first morning urine** in the plastic jug. The collection is now complete. Please <u>write the ending time and date on the plastic jug.</u>
- 6. Return your jug to the Laboratory as soon as possible after completion, during the day of the final collection. Keep on ice until returned to the laboratory.
- 7. When complete, your jug should be labeled with your name, the time you started and ended your collection. *Example*: JANE DOE Start Date /Time: 8am Jan 1, 2016 End Date /Time: 8am Jan 2, 2016
