

HPV High Risk PCR Testing Order Updates

What's new?

Effective August 12th, 2025, VCU Health Medical Campus Microbiology Laboratory will modify the <u>HPV HIGH RISK PCR TESTING [LAB2339]</u> and <u>PAP TEST [LAB4]</u> order to offer the following STI co-tests.

- Chlamydia trachomatis (CT)
- Neisseria gonorrhoeae (NG)
- Trichomonas vaginalis (TV)



Acceptable Specimen: Clinician collected cervical specimen in a ThinPrep® PreservCyt Collection Vial

Turnaround Time: 21 day maximum, 5 days expected

Explanation:

ThinPrep® PreservCyt Collection Vials are FDA-approved/cleared for HPV, chlamydia/gonorrhea and trichomoniasis testing out of the same vial.


Important:

- CT, NG, and TV co-testing will <u>only</u> be offered when HPV HR PCR tests are ordered.
- Self-collect vaginal specimens are <u>not</u> acceptable for Cytology or HPV HR/STI testing.
- This will not replace the standalone CT, NG, and TV PCR tests and those collection devices.


