

"Morphologic Features of Indeterminate Thyroid FNAs and Their Correlation with ThyroSeq"

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At the conclusion of this activity, the participant will be able to:

1. Describe the key nuclear and architectural features used in the cytologic evaluation of thyroid fine-needle aspiration specimens classified as Bethesda III (AUS/FLUS) and Bethesda IV (Follicular Neoplasm/Suspicious for Follicular Neoplasm)
2. Evaluate the degree of interobserver variability among pathologists in assessing specific cytomorphologic features and understand its impact on diagnostic classification and patient management
3. Correlate individual cytologic features with ThyroSeq molecular testing results to identify morphologic findings that may predict the presence of clinically significant genetic alterations
